Gen. 37:6-7-⁶ He said to them, "Please listen to this dream which I have had; ⁷ for behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and lo, my sheaf rose up and also stood erect; and behold, your sheaves gathered around and **bowed** down to my sheaf."

Gen. 37:9-10-⁹ Now he had still another dream, and related it to his brothers, and said, "Lo, I have had still another dream; and behold, the sun and the moon and eleven stars were **bowing** down to me." ¹⁰ He related *it* to his father and to his brothers; and his father rebuked him and said to him, "What is this dream that you have had? Shall I and your mother and your brothers actually come to **bow** ourselves down before you to the ground?"

Gen. 42:32-We are twelve brothers, sons of our <u>father</u>; one is no longer alive, and the youngest is with our father today in the land of Canaan.

<u>28</u>

Gen. 37:6-7-⁶ He said to them, "Please listen to this dream which I have had; ⁷ for behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and lo, my sheaf rose up and also stood erect; and behold, your sheaves gathered around and **bowed** down to my sheaf."

Gen. 37:9-10-9 Now he had still another dream, and related it to his brothers, and said, "Lo, I have had still another dream; and behold, the sun and the moon and eleven stars were **bowing** down to me." ¹⁰ He related *it* to his father and to his brothers; and his father rebuked him and said to him, "What is this dream that you

have had? Shall I and your mother and your brothers actually come to **bow** ourselves down before you to the ground?"

Gen. 42:6-Now Joseph was the ruler over the land; he was the one who sold to all the people of the land. And Joseph's brothers came and **bowed** down to him with *their* faces to the ground.

Gen. 43:26-When Joseph came home, they brought into the house to him the present which was in their hand and **bowed** to the ground before him.

Gen. 43:28-They said, "Your servant our father is well; he is still alive." They **bowed down** in homage.

Gen. 44:14-When Judah and his brothers came to Joseph's house, he was still there, and they **fell to the ground before him**.

<u>30</u>

Gen. 42:24-He turned away from them and <u>wept</u>. But when he returned to them and spoke to them, he took Simeon from them and bound him before their eyes.

Gen. 45:1-2-Then Joseph could not control himself before all those who stood by him, and he **cried**, "Have everyone go out from me." So, there was no man with him when Joseph made himself known to his brothers. He **wept** so loudly that the Egyptians heard *it*, and the household of Pharaoh heard *of it*.

Gen. 45:14-15-¹⁴ Then he fell on his brother Benjamin's neck and <u>wept</u>, and Benjamin wept on his neck. ¹⁵ He kissed all his brothers and <u>wept</u> on them, and afterward his brothers talked with him.

Gen. 50:17-'Thus you shall say to Joseph, "Please forgive, I beg you, the transgression of your brothers and their sin, for they did you wrong." And now, please forgive the transgression of the servants of the God of your father." And Joseph <u>wept</u> when they spoke to him.

Isa. 53:3-He was despised and forsaken of men, <u>a man</u> <u>of sorrows and acquainted with grief</u>; And like one from whom men hide their face. He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

John 11:35-Jesus wept.

Gen. 46:34-you shall say, 'Your servants have been keepers of livestock from our youth even until now, both we and our fathers,' that you may live in the land of Goshen; **for every shepherd is loathsome to the Egyptians**."

Luke 2:8-12- ⁸ In the same region there were *some* shepherds staying out in the fields and keeping watch over their flock by night. ⁹ And an angel of the Lord suddenly stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them; and they were terribly frightened. ¹⁰ But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of great joy which will be for all the people; ¹¹ for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. ¹² This *will be* a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."

Gen. 42:15-16- ¹⁵ by this you will be <u>tested</u>: by the life of Pharaoh, you shall not go from this place unless your youngest brother comes here! ¹⁶ Send one of you that he may get your brother, while you remain confined, that your words may be <u>tested</u>, whether there is truth in you. But if not, by the life of Pharaoh, surely you are spies.

Gen. 37:3-Now Israel <u>loved</u> Joseph more than all his sons, because he was the son of his old age; and he made him a <u>varicolored tunic</u>.

Gen. 37:4-His brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers; and *so* they **hated** him and could not speak to him on friendly terms.

1 Pet. 2:2-like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may **grow** in respect to salvation.
