Who is led into sin without my intense concern? ³⁰ If I have to boast, I will boast of what pertains to my weakness.³¹ The God and Father of the Lord Jesus, He who is blessed forever, knows that I am not lying. 32 In Damascus the ethnarch under Aretas the king was guarding the city of the Damascenes in order to seize me, 33 and I was let down in a basket through a window in the wall, and so escaped his hands.

2 Tim. 3:12-Indeed, all who desire to live **godly** in Christ Jesus will be **persecuted**.

John 15:18-20-¹⁸ "If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before *it hated* you. ¹⁹ If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world,

Acts 10:42-45-⁴² And He ordered us to preach to the people, and solemnly to testify that this is the One who has been appointed by God as Judge of the living and the dead. ⁴³ Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who **believes** in Him receives forgiveness of sins." ⁴⁴ While Peter was still speaking these words, **the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message**. ⁴⁵ All the circumcised believers who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. ⁴⁶ For they were hearing them speaking with tongues and exalting God. Then Peter answered, ⁴⁷ "Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be **baptized** who have **received the Holy Spirit just as**

we did, can he?" ⁴⁸ And he ordered them to be <u>baptized</u> in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay on for a few days.

Acts 16:14-15-¹⁴ A woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple fabrics, a worshiper of God, was listening; and the Lord opened her heart to **respond** to the things spoken by Paul. ¹⁵ And when she and her household had been **baptized**, she urged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house and stay." And she prevailed upon us.

Acts 16:30-34-³⁰ and after he brought them out, he said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" ³¹ They said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." ³² And they spoke the word of the Lord to him together with all who were in his house. ³³ And he took them that *very* hour of the night and washed their wounds, and immediately he was **baptized**, he and all his *household*. ³⁴ And he brought them into his house and set food before them, and rejoiced greatly, having **believed** in God with his whole household.

Acts 18:8-Crispus, the leader of the synagogue, **believed** in the Lord with all his household, and many of the Corinthians when they heard were **believing** and being **baptized**.
