Rom. 1:16-For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, **to the Jew first** and also to the Greek.

### <u>22</u>

Acts 18:24-Now a Jew named Apollos, an Alexandrian by birth, an eloquent man, came to Ephesus; and he was <u>mighty in the Scriptures</u>.

Gal. 1:15-18-<sup>15</sup> But when God, who had set me apart *even* from my mother's womb and called me through His grace, was pleased <sup>16</sup> to reveal His Son in me so that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with flesh and blood, <sup>17</sup> nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me; but I went away to <u>Arabia</u>, and returned once more to <u>Damascus</u>. <sup>18</sup> Then <u>three years</u> later I went up to <u>Jerusalem</u> to become acquainted with Cephas and stayed with him fifteen days.

### <u>23</u>

2 Tim. 3:12-Indeed, all who desire to live **godly** in Christ Jesus will be **persecuted**.

John 15:18-20-<sup>18</sup> "If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before *it hated* you. <sup>19</sup> If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you. <sup>20</sup> Remember the world that I said to you, 'A slave is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

# <u>25</u>

2 Cor. 11:32-33-<sup>32</sup> In **Damascus** the ethnarch under Aretas the king was guarding the city of the Damascenes in order to seize me, <sup>33</sup> and I was let down in a **basket** through a window in the wall, and *so* escaped his hands.

Josh. 2:15-Then she <u>let them down by a rope through the</u> <u>window</u>, for her house was on the city wall, so that she was living on the wall.

### <u>26</u>

Gal. 1:18-20- <sup>18</sup> Then three years later I went up to <u>Jerusalem</u> to become acquainted with Cephas and stayed with him fifteen days. <sup>19</sup> But <u>I did not see any other of the apostles except James</u>, the Lord's brother. <sup>20</sup> (Now in what I am writing to you, I assure you before God that I am not lying.)

Gal. 1:18-19-<sup>18</sup> Then three years later I went up to Jerusalem to become <u>acquainted with Cephas</u>, and stayed with him <u>fifteen days</u>. <sup>19</sup> But I did not see any other of the apostles except James, the Lord's brother.

1 Cor. 15:8-9-8 and last of all, as to one untimely born, <u>He</u> <u>appeared to me also</u>. 9 For I am the least of the apostles, and not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

# <u>28</u>

2 Tim. 1:7-For God has not given us a spirit of <u>timidity</u>, but of power and love and discipline.

Gal. 1:18- <sup>18</sup> Then three years later I went up to <u>Jerusalem</u> to become acquainted with Cephas and stayed with him <u>fifteen</u> <u>days</u>.

# <u>29</u>

Acts 6:1-Now at this time while the disciples were increasing *in number*, a complaint arose on the part of the <u>Hellenistic Jews</u> against the *native Hebrews*, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily serving *of food*.

Acts 6:9-But some men from what was called the Synagogue of the Freedmen, *including* both <u>Cyrenians and Alexandrians</u>, and some from Cilicia and Asia, rose up and argued with <u>Stephen</u>.

### <u>30</u>

Gal. 1:21-Then I went into the regions of **Syria and Cilicia**.

2 Cor. 12:1-4-Boasting is necessary, though it is not profitable; but I will go on to visions and revelations of the Lord. <sup>2</sup>I know a man in Christ who **fourteen years ago**—whether in the body I do not know, or out of the body I do not know, God knows—such a man was caught up to the third heaven. <sup>3</sup> And I know how such a man—whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, God knows—<sup>4</sup> was caught up into Paradise and heard inexpressible words, which a man is not permitted to speak.

# **31**

1 Cor. 14:26- What is *the outcome* then, brethren? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.

Prov. 1:7- The <u>fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge</u>; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.

John 14:26-27- <sup>26</sup>But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you. <sup>27</sup>Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; <u>not as the world gives</u> do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

John 16:33-These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have **peace**. In the world you have tribulation but take courage; I have overcome the world.

Matt. 16:19-I will give you the **keys of the kingdom** of heaven; and whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven.

Acts 8:40-But Philip found himself at <u>Azotus</u>, and as he passed through he kept preaching the gospel to <u>all the cities</u> until he came to <u>Caesarea</u>.

# <u>35</u>

1 Thess. 1:9-For they themselves report about us what kind of a reception we had with you, and how you <u>turned to</u> <u>God from idols</u> to serve a living and true God

Acts 2:38-Peter *said* to them, "**Repent**, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:44-And all those who had **believed** were together and had all things in common

Acts 17:30-Therefore, having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all *people* everywhere should **repent**.

Acts 17:34-But some men joined him and **believed**, among whom also were Dionysius the Areopagite and a woman named Damaris and others with them.

#### **36**

Jonah 1:3-But Jonah rose up to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. So he went down to **Joppa**, found a ship which was

going to Tarshish, paid the fare and went down into it to go with them to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord.

### <u>37</u>

Heb. 9:27-And inasmuch as it is appointed for men **to die once** and after this *comes* judgment.

### <u>40</u>

Mark 5:40-41-<sup>40</sup> They *began* laughing at Him. But <u>putting them</u> <u>all out</u>, He \*took along the child's father and mother and His own companions, and \*entered *the room* where the child was. <sup>41</sup> Taking the child by the hand, He \*said to her, "Talitha kum!" (which translated means, "Little girl, I say to you, get up!").

# <u>42</u>

Isa. 55:10-11- 10 "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven, And do not return there without watering the earth And making it bear and sprout, And furnishing seed to the sower and bread to the eater; 11 So will **My word** be which goes forth from My mouth; It **will not return to Me empty**, Without accomplishing what I desire, And without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.

Jer. 23:29-"Is not My **word** like fire?" declares the Lord, "and like a hammer which shatters a rock?"

Luke 16:27-31-<sup>27</sup> And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, that you send him to my father's house—<sup>28</sup> for I have five brothers—in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.' <sup>29</sup> But Abraham \*said, 'They have Moses

and the Prophets; let them hear them.' <sup>30</sup> But he said, 'No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!' <sup>31</sup> But he said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead."'

Rom. 10:17-So, faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the **word** of Christ.

2 Tim. 3:15-4:2-15 and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 16 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; 17 so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work. 1 I solemnly charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: 2 preach the word; be ready in season and out of season: reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.

Jas. 1:18-In the exercise of His will He brought us forth by the **word** of truth, so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures.

1 Pet. 1:23-for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring **word** of God.

Lev. 11:39-40-<sup>39</sup> 'Also if one of the animals dies which you have for food, the one who touches its carcass becomes unclean until evening. <sup>40</sup> He too, who eats some of its carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening, and the one who picks up its carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening.

Acts 10:13-14-13 A voice came to him, "Get up, Peter, kill and eat!" <sup>14</sup> But Peter said, "By no means, Lord, for I have never eaten anything unholy and unclean."
