Gen. 37:14-Then he said to him, "Go now and see about the welfare of your brothers and the welfare of the flock, and bring word back to me." So he sent him from the <u>valley of Hebron</u>, and he came to Shechem.

#### <u>19</u>

Acts 28:10- They also honored us with many marks of respect; and when we were setting sail, **they supplied us with all we needed**.

Philip. 4:19-And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

# <u>20</u>

Gen. 47:11-So Joseph settled his father and his brothers and gave them a possession in the land of Egypt, in the best of the land, <u>in</u> the land of Rameses, as Pharaoh had ordered.

# <u>22</u>

Deut. 8:4-Your <u>clothing</u> did not wear out on you, nor did your foot swell these forty years.

Gen. 43:34-He took portions to them from his own table, but Benjamin's portion was **five times** as much as any of theirs. So they feasted and drank freely with him.
