Gen. 42:24-He turned away from them and <u>wept</u>. But when he returned to them and spoke to them, he took Simeon from them and bound him before their eyes.

Gen. 45:1-2-Then Joseph could not control himself before all those who stood by him, and he <u>cried</u>, "Have everyone go out from me." So, there was no man with him when Joseph made himself known to his brothers.² He <u>wept</u> so loudly that the Egyptians heard *it*, and the household of Pharaoh heard *of it*.

Gen. 45:14-15-¹⁴ Then he fell on his brother Benjamin's neck and <u>wept</u>, and Benjamin wept on his neck.¹⁵ He kissed all his brothers and <u>wept</u> on them, and afterward his brothers talked with him.
