Prov. 1:7-**Fear of the Lord is the foundation of true knowledge**, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.

Luke 16:10-If you are faithful in little things, you will be faithful in large ones. But if you are dishonest in little things, you won't be honest with greater responsibilities.

Isa. 6:1-It was in the year King Uzziah died that **I saw the Lord**. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple.

Isa. 6:5-Then I said, "Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have **seen** the King, the Lord of hosts."

Rev. 1:17-When I saw Him, **I fell at His feet like a dead man**. And He placed His right hand on me, saying, "Do not be afraid; I am the first and the last."

Luke 5:8-But when Simon Peter saw *that*, he fell down at Jesus' feet, saying, "**Go away from me Lord, for I am a sinful man!**"

Gen. 3:8-They heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife **hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God** among the trees of the garden.

Lev. 11:39-40-³⁹ 'Also if one of the animals dies which you have for food, the one who touches its carcass becomes unclean until

evening. ⁴⁰ He too, who eats some of its carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening, and the one who picks up its carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening.

Dan. 6:10-Now when Daniel knew that the document was signed, he entered his house (**now in his roof chamber he had windows open toward Jerusalem**); **and he continued kneeling on his knees three times a day**, praying and giving thanks before his God, as he had been doing previously.

Lev. 10:10-and so as to make a distinction between the **holy and the profane**, and between the **unclean and the clean**.

Lev. 20:25-You are therefore to make a distinction between the clean animal and the unclean, and between the unclean bird and the clean; and you shall not make yourselves detestable by animal or by bird or by anything that creeps on the ground, which I have separated for you as unclean.

Ezek. 4:14- But I said, “Ah, Lord God! Behold, I have never been defiled; for from my youth until now I have never eaten what died of itself or was torn by beasts, nor has any unclean meat ever entered my mouth.”

Dan. 1:8-12- ⁸ But Daniel made up his mind that he would not defile himself with the king’s choice food or with the wine which he drank; so he sought *permission* from the commander of the officials that he might not defile himself. ⁹ Now God granted Daniel favor and compassion in the sight of the commander of the

officials, ¹⁰ and the commander of the officials said to Daniel, “I am afraid of my lord the king, who has appointed your food and your drink; for why should he see your faces looking more haggard than the youths who are your own age? Then you would make me forfeit my head to the king.” ¹¹ But Daniel said to the overseer whom the commander of the officials had appointed over Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah, ¹² “Please test your servants for ten days, and let us be given some vegetables to eat and water to drink.

Matt. 15:16-20- ¹⁶ Jesus said, “Are you still lacking in understanding also? ¹⁷ Do you not understand that everything that goes into the mouth passes into the stomach, and is eliminated? ¹⁸ But the things that proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and those defile the man. ¹⁹ For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, slanders. ²⁰ These are the things which defile the man; but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile the man.”

Mark 7:18-19- ¹⁸ And He said to them, “Are you so lacking in understanding also? Do you not understand that whatever goes into the man from outside cannot defile him, ¹⁹ because it does not go into his heart, but into his stomach, and is eliminated?” (*Thus He declared all foods clean.*)

1 Cor. 10:19-What do I mean then? That **a thing sacrificed to idols is anything**, or that an idol is anything?

Rom. 14:14-I know and am convinced in the Lord Jesus that **nothing is unclean in itself**; but to him who thinks anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean.

Col. 2:16-17- ¹⁶Therefore **no one is to act as your judge in regard to food or drink** or in respect to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath day— ¹⁷things which are a *mere* shadow of what is to come; but the substance belongs to Christ.

1 Tim. 4:3-4 - ³*men* who forbid marriage *and* advocate **abstaining from foods** which God has created to be gratefully shared in by those who believe and know the truth. ⁴For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with gratitude

Acts 1:22-beginning with the baptism of John until the day that **He was taken up** from us—one of these *must* become a witness with us of His resurrection.

2 Cor. 3:7-11-⁷ But if the ministry of death, in letters engraved on stones, came with glory, so that the sons of Israel could not look intently at the face of Moses because of the glory of his face, **fading** as it was, ⁸how will the ministry of the Spirit fail to be even more with glory? ⁹For if the ministry of condemnation has glory, much more does the ministry of righteousness abound in glory. ¹⁰For indeed what had glory, in this case has no glory because of the glory that surpasses it. ¹¹For if that which **fades** away was with glory, much more that which remains is in glory.

Rom. 6:14-For sin shall not be master over you, for **you are not under law** but under grace.

Gal. 6:2-Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the **law of Christ**.

Rom. 8:2-For the **law of the Spirit** of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death.
