

### 47:3

Gen. 43:34-He took portions to them from his own table, but Benjamin's portion was **five times** as much as any of theirs. So they feasted and drank freely with him.

Gen. 46:33-When Pharaoh calls you and says, '**What is your occupation?**'

Gen. 45:8- Now, therefore, it was not you who sent me here, but God; and He has made me a **father to Pharaoh** and lord of all his household and ruler over all the land of Egypt.
