Gen. 40:51-52-⁵⁰ Now before the year of famine came, two sons were born to Joseph, whom <u>Asenath, the daughter of Potiphera priest of On</u>, bore to him. ⁵¹ Joseph named the firstborn <u>Manasseh</u>, "For," *he said*, "God has made me forget all my trouble and all my father's household." He named the second <u>Ephraim</u>, "For," *he said*, "God has made me fruitful in the land of my affliction."

<u>10</u>

Deut. 34:7-Although Moses was one hundred and twenty years old when he died, his **eye was not dim**, nor his vigor abated.

<u>11</u>

Eph. 3:20-Now to Him who is **able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think**, according to the power that works within us

Ps. 37:4-Delight yourself in the Lord; And He will give you the **desires** of your heart.

<u>13</u>

Ps. 110:1-The Lord says to my Lord: "Sit at My <u>right</u> hand Until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."

Eccles. 10:2-A wise man's heart *directs him* toward the <u>right</u>, but the foolish man's heart *directs him* toward the left.

Matt. 25:33-and He will put the sheep on His <u>right</u>, and the goats on the left.

Ps. 23:1-The Lord is my **shepherd**; I shall not want.

Ps. 23:6-Surely goodness and lovingkindness will follow me all the days of my life, And I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

<u>16</u>

Job 19:25-As for me, I know that my **Redeemer** lives, and at the last He will take His stand on the earth.

Gal. 3:16-Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as *referring* to many, but *rather* to one, "And to your <u>seed</u>," that is, Christ.

Gen. 49:33-When <u>Jacob</u> finished charging his sons, he drew his feet into the bed and <u>breathed his last</u>, and was gathered to his people.

Gen. 46:4-I will go down with you to **Egypt, and I will also surely bring you up again**; and Joseph will close your eyes.

Gen. 37:3-Now <u>Israel loved Joseph more than all his sons</u>, because he was the son of his old age; and he made him a varicolored tunic.

Gen. 33:19-He bought the piece of land where he had pitched his tent from the hand of the sons of Hamor, Shechem's father, for one hundred pieces of money.

John 4:5-6-5 So He came to a city of Samaria called Sychar, near the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph; 6 and Jacob's well was there. So Jesus, being wearied from His journey, was sitting thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

Josh. 24:32-Now they buried the bones of Joseph, which the sons of Israel brought up from Egypt, at Shechem, in the piece of ground which <u>Jacob had bought from the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem</u> for one hundred pieces of money; and they became the inheritance of Joseph's sons.
