Gen. 49:1-Then Jacob summoned his sons and said, "Assemble yourselves that I may tell you what <u>will befall you in the days to</u> <u>come</u>.

Gen. 49:33-When <u>Jacob</u> finished charging his sons, he drew his feet into the bed and <u>breathed his last</u>, and was gathered to his people.

Gen. 47:28-Jacob lived in the land of Egypt seventeen years; so the length of Jacob's life was <u>one hundred and forty-seven</u> <u>years</u>.

Exod. 12:35-36-³⁵ Now the sons of Israel had done according to the word of Moses, for they had <u>requested from the Egyptians</u> <u>articles of silver and articles of gold, and clothing</u>; ³⁶ and the Lord had given the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they let them have their request. Thus, they <u>plundered the</u> <u>Egyptians</u>.

Gen. 46:4-I will go down with you to **Egypt, and I will also surely bring you up again**; and Joseph will close your eyes.

Gen. 37:3-Now **Israel loved Joseph more than all his sons**, because he was the son of his old age; and he made him a varicolored tunic.

Gen. 43:34-He took portions to them from his own table, but Benjamin's portion was five times as much as any of theirs. So they feasted and drank freely with him. Gen. 33:19-He bought the piece of <u>land</u> where he had pitched his tent from the hand of the sons of Hamor, <u>Shechem's</u> father, for one hundred pieces of money.

John 4:5-6-⁵ <u>So He came to a city of Samaria called Sychar,</u> <u>near the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son</u> <u>Joseph; ⁶ and Jacob's well was there</u>. So Jesus, being wearied from His journey, was sitting thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

Josh. 24:32-Now they **buried the bones of Joseph**, which the sons of Israel brought up from Egypt, at Shechem, in the piece of ground which **Jacob had bought from the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem** for one hundred pieces of money; and they became the inheritance of Joseph's sons.

Gen. 49:5-7-⁵"<u>Simeon and Levi</u> are brothers; Their swords are implements of violence. ⁶"Let my soul not enter into their council; Let not my glory be united with their assembly; Because in their anger they slew men, and in their self-will they lamed oxen. ⁷"Cursed be their anger, for it is fierce; <u>And their</u> <u>wrath, for it is cruel. I will disperse them in Jacob And scatter</u> <u>them in Israel</u>."

Heb. 11:6-And without faith it is **<u>impossible</u>** to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.
