John 1:12-But as many as <u>received</u> Him, to them He gave the right to. become children of God, *even* to those who <u>believe</u> in His name.

Acts 15:5-But some of the <u>sect of the Pharisees</u> who had believed stood up, saying, "It is necessary to circumcise them and to direct them to observe the Law of Moses."

Gal. 2:12-For prior to the coming of certain <u>men from James</u>, he used to eat with the Gentiles; but when they came, he *began* to withdraw and hold himself aloof, fearing the party of the circumcision.

<u>3</u>

Acts 10:27-28-²⁷ As he talked with him, he entered and found many people assembled. ²⁸ And he said to them, "You yourselves know how **unlawful** it is for a man who is a Jew to associate with a foreigner or to visit him; and *yet* God has shown me that I should not call any man unholy or unclean.

<u>8</u>

Acts 10:14-But Peter said, "<u>By no means, Lord</u>, for I have never eaten anything unholy and unclean."

1 Pet. 3:15-but <u>sanctify Christ as Lord</u> in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence.

Acts 9:43-And Peter stayed many days in <u>Joppa</u> with a tanner named Simon.

Jas. 1:6-8-⁶ But he must ask in faith <u>without any doubting</u>, for the one who doubts is like the surf of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind. ⁷ For that man ought not to expect that he will receive anything from the Lord, ⁸ *being* a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

<u>15</u>

Acts 2:1-4-When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. ² And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.³ And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them. ⁴ And they were all <u>filled with the Holy Spirit</u> and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance.

Acts 10:43-44-⁴³ Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who <u>believes</u> in Him receives forgiveness of sins." ⁴⁴ While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message.

Acts 15:11-But we believe that we are saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus, <u>in the same way as they also are</u>.

Luke 15:7-I tell you that in the same way, there will be *more* <u>joy</u> <u>in heaven</u> over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.
