Acts 9:43-And Peter stayed many days in **Joppa** with a tanner named Simon.

## 12

Jas. 1:6-8-<sup>6</sup> But he must ask in faith **without any doubting**, for the one who doubts is like the surf of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind. <sup>7</sup> For that man ought not to expect that he will receive anything from the Lord, <sup>8</sup> *being* a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

Deut. 17:6-On the evidence of **two witnesses or three witnesses**, he who is to die shall be put to death; he shall not be put to death on the evidence of one witness.

1 Tim. 5:19-Do not receive an accusation against an elder except on the basis of **two or three witnesses**.

Acts 10:27-28-<sup>27</sup> As he talked with him, he entered and found many people assembled. <sup>28</sup> And he said to them, “You yourselves know how **unlawful** it is for a man who is a Jew to associate with a foreigner or to visit him; and *yet* God has shown me that I should not call any man unholy or unclean.

Ruth 1:16-But Ruth said, “Do not urge me to leave you or turn back from following you; for where you go, I will go, and where you lodge, I will lodge. **Your people shall be my people, and your God, my God.**

Matt. 23:15-Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you travel around on sea and land to make one **proselyte**;

and when he becomes one, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

## 15

Acts 2:1-4-When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. <sup>2</sup> And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup> And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them. <sup>4</sup> And they were all **filled with the Holy Spirit** and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance.

Acts 10:43-44-<sup>43</sup> Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who **believes** in Him receives forgiveness of sins.” <sup>44</sup> While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message.

Acts 15:11-But we believe that we are saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus, **in the same way as they also are.**

## 18

Luke 15:7-I tell you that in the same way, there will be *more* **joy in heaven** over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.
