Gen. 37:26-27-<sup>26</sup> Judah said to his brothers, "What profit is it for us to <u>kill</u> our brother and cover up his blood? <sup>27</sup> Come and let us <u>sell</u> him to the Ishmaelites and not lay our hands on him, for he is our brother, our *own* flesh." And his brothers listened *to him*.

apparel, Marching in the greatness of His strength? "It is I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save." <sup>2</sup> Why is Your apparel red, And Your garments like the one who treads in the wine press? <sup>3</sup> "I have trodden the wine trough alone, And from the peoples there was no man with Me. I also trod them in My anger And trampled them in My wrath; And their lifeblood is sprinkled on My garments, And I stained all My raiment. <sup>4</sup> "For the day of vengeance was in My heart, And My year of redemption has come. <sup>5</sup> "I looked, and there was no one to help, And I was astonished and there was no one to uphold; So My own arm brought salvation to Me, And My wrath upheld Me. <sup>6</sup> "<u>I trod</u> down the peoples in My anger And made them drunk in My wrath, And I poured out their lifeblood on the earth."
