Jer. 49:1- Concerning the sons of Ammon. Thus says the Lord: "Does Israel have no sons? Or has he no heirs? Why then has **Malcam taken possession of Gad** And his people settled in its cities?"

Deut. 33:20- Of Gad he said, "Blessed is the one who enlarges **Gad**; He lies down as a **lion**, and **tears** the arm, also the crown of the head."

1 Chron. 5:18-22-<sup>18</sup> The sons of Reuben and the <u>Gadites</u> and the half-tribe of Manasseh, consisting of <u>valiant</u> men, men who bore <u>shield and sword and shot</u> with bow and were <u>skillful in battle</u>, were 44,760, who went <u>to war</u>. <sup>19</sup> They made <u>war</u> against the Hagrites, Jetur, Naphish and Nodab. <sup>20</sup> They were helped against them, and the Hagrites and all who were with them were given into their hand; for they cried out to God in the battle, and He answered their prayers because they trusted in Him. <sup>21</sup> They took away their cattle: their 50,000 camels, 250,000 sheep, 2,000 donkeys; and 100,000 men. <sup>22</sup> For many fell slain, because the war was of God. And they settled in their place until the exile.

1 Chron. 12:8-15-8 From the <u>Gadites</u> there came over to David in the stronghold in the wilderness, <u>mighty men of valor, men trained for war, who could handle shield and spear</u>, and whose faces were like the faces of lions, and they were as swift as the gazelles on the mountains. 9 Ezer wasthe first, Obadiah the second, Eliab the third, <sup>10</sup> Mishmannah the fourth, Jeremiah the fifth, <sup>11</sup> Attai the sixth, Eliel the seventh, <sup>12</sup> Johanan the eighth, Elzabad the ninth, <sup>13</sup> Jeremiah the tenth, Machbannai the

eleventh. <sup>14</sup> These of the sons of Gad were captains of the army; he who was least was equal to a hundred and the greatest to a thousand. <sup>15</sup> These are the ones who crossed the Jordan in the first month when it was overflowing all its banks and they put to <u>flight</u> all those in the valleys, both to the east and to the west.

1 Chron. 12:37- From the other side of the Jordan, of the Reubenites and the <u>Gadites</u> and of the half-tribe of Manasseh, there were 120,000 with <u>all kinds of weapons of war for the battle</u>.

Lev. 26:43-For the <u>land will be abandoned by them</u>, and will make up for its sabbaths while it is <u>made desolate without them</u>. They, meanwhile, will be making amends for their iniquity, because they rejected My ordinances and their soul abhorred My statutes.

Judges 4:6-Now she sent and summoned Barak the son of Abinoam from Kedesh-naphtali, and said to him, "Behold, the Lord, the God of Israel, has commanded, 'Go and march to Mount Tabor, and take with you ten thousand men from the sons of **Naphtali** and from the sons of Zebulun.

Judges 4:10-Barak called Zebulun and <u>Naphtali</u> together to Kedesh, and ten thousand men went up with him; Deborah also went up with him.

Judges 4:16-But Barak pursued the chariots and the army as far as Harosheth-hagoyim, and all **the army of Sisera fell by the edge of the sword**; not even one was left.

Prov. 18:21-<u>Death and life are in the power of the tongue</u>, And those who love it will eat its fruit.
