



#### Bible Prophecy Requires It: Why the Third Temple is so Important



- Christ will purify and rebuild the Temple in the Kingdom (Dan. 12:11-12; Ezek. 37:26-28; 40-48)






#### Prophecies Related to the Temple Mount

- 2. Jerusalem would regain its national status as "the capital of Israel" (Matthew 24:15-22).
- 3. Israeli Jews would rebuild Temple. (Mt. 24:15; Rev. 11:1-2).
- 4. Jerusalem would again be threatened by the Gentile nations (Ezekiel 38-39; Zechariah 12:2; 14:2).
















### The Astonishing Israeli Concession of 1967





In a video taken from the courtyards of the mosque, the far-right minister said the Jerusalem site "belongs only to the state of Israel".





# Why it matters that Jews are standing on the Temple Mount

Jews are increasingly staking a claim to the Muslim-controlled Temple Mount, testing the Israeli government's resolve to avoid conflict by protecting Muslim sovereignty over the site.



It is noteworthy to recall that on the day of the Temple Mount's capture during the Six Day War, Rabbi Goren, who reached the site with the first Israeli Paratroopers, urged Defense Minister Moshe Dayan to take advantage of the moment and blow up the Shrine of the Dome which was built over the site of the Temple. Dayan refused.







It is said that this is where the world began-and perhaps where it will end.

The true epicenter of the war in the Holy Land is not the devastated Gaza Strip, under Israeli assault since <a href="Hamas">Hamas</a>' bloody raid last October sparked the region's deadliest conflict in decades. It is a few dozen miles away in Jerusalem, at the holiest and most fiercely contested hilltop on Earth. The war has increased religious tensions and given new impetus to a group of Jews and their evangelical Christian allies who are set on rebuilding an ancient temple where millennium-old Islamic shrines now stand—a suggestion that arouses the horror not only of Palestinians and Muslims worldwide, but of many Jews in Israel and around the globe as well as that of would-be Middle East peacemakers.

Third Temple advocates have been preparing for the day when the temple can be rebuilt, complete with rabbinically-certified red cows shipped from Texas for use in sacrificial purification rituals. The architectural designs are all ready, along the lines of the detailed Biblical descriptions. Robes have been woven and utensils assembled to Biblical specifications for ceremonies at the planned temple.

### Israel Defense Minister: These are the Days of the Third Temple!

Israel Defense Minister Naftali Bennett last Wednesday insisted that these are the days of the Third Temple, and that the modern State of Israel is very much a part of the prophesied global redemption.

Speaking at a yeshiva (Jewish seminary) in the north of Israel ahead of next month's election, Bennett explained why he was trying to keep another religious right-wing politician out of the Knesset.

According to Bennett, the controversial Itamar Ben Gvir, like many Orthodox Jews, fails to recognize the biblical and prophetic significance and authority of the <u>State of Israel</u> and its institutions.

Bennett went on to explain that despite its long history, Israel has only managed to rule as a unified nation in this land for two very short periods, and that because of internal divisions and the failure to submit to a central authority.

"We have had a state twice where we ruled as a united people. The first time it only lasted 80 years – King David 40, then King Solomon 40. After that, we separated," said Bennett. "The second time, we were sovereign for only 74 years during the Hasmonean dynasty." (See: "How Long Will Israel's Third Kingdom Survive?")

Likewise, the Second Temple was destroyed because everyone "followed their own rules," the defense minister said, before exclaiming, "We need to understand the big picture. Today we are in the time of the Third Temple!"

Yes, the State of Israel is a liberal, largely-secular democracy. And yet, faith in the Bible and belief in the prophecies it contains regarding this nation continue to play a major role in Israeli politics.






# What Could the End of the War Hold for Jerusalem and the Temple Mount?







# Could the Rebuilding of the Third Temple Be a Sign That the Rapture is Closer?


The recent developments in Jerusalem regarding plans to rebuild the Third Temple have reignited debates among religious scholars, historians, and global watchers. This sacred site, Mount Moriah—housing both the Al-Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock—has a complex history of division and contention between the Jewish and Muslim faiths (Dena Takruri, 2022; Henry, 2022). Many now ask whether the strategic division of this holy land, instigated by powerful political forces and secret societies, was a calculated move to ignite a Third World War that would usher in a New World Order.
