Heb. 13:6-so that we confidently say, "<u>The Lord is my helper</u>, I will not be afraid. What will man do to me?"

Ps. 54:4-Behold, God is my <u>helper</u>; The Lord is the sustainer of my soul.

Rev. 4:8-And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes around and within; and day and night they do not cease to say, "Holy, holy, holy *is* the Lord God, the <u>Almighty</u>, who was and who is and who is to come."

Gen. 5:2-He created them male and female, and He **<u>blessed</u>** them and named them Man in the day when they were created.

Ps. 1:1-How **<u>blessed</u>** is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers!

John 13:17-If you know these things, you are **<u>blessed</u>** if you do them.

Gen. 27:39-Then Isaac his father answered and said to him, "Behold, away from the fertility of the earth shall be your dwelling, And away from the <u>dew</u> of heaven from above."

Deut. 33:13-Of Joseph he said, "Blessed of the Lord *be* his land, With the choice things of heaven, with the <u>dew</u>, and from the deep lying beneath."

Deut. 33:13-Of Joseph he said, "Blessed of the Lord *be* his land, With the choice things of heaven, with the dew, and from the <u>deep</u> <u>lying beneath</u>." 1 Kgs. 17:2-6-<sup>2</sup> The word of the Lord came to him, saying, <sup>3</sup> "Go away from here and turn eastward, and hide yourself by the brook Cherith, which is east of the Jordan. <sup>4</sup> It shall be that you will drink of the brook, and I have commanded the ravens to provide for you there." <sup>5</sup> So he went and did according to the word of the Lord, for he went and lived by the brook Cherith, which is east of the Jordan. <sup>6</sup> The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he would drink from the brook.

## <u>26</u>

Exod. 21:6- then his master shall bring him to God, then he shall bring him to the door or the doorpost. And his master shall pierce his ear with an awl; and he shall serve him **<u>permanently</u>**.

Gen. 37:4- His brothers saw that their father loved him more than all **<u>his brothers</u>**; and *so* they **<u>hated him</u>** and could not speak to him on friendly terms.

Rev. 3:9-Behold, I will cause those of the <u>synagogue of Satan</u>, who say that they are Jews and are not, but lie—<u>I will make</u> <u>them come and bow down at your feet and make them know</u> <u>that I have loved you</u>.
