## **Title**

- Exod. 19:1-In the third month <u>after the children of Israel were</u> gone forth out of the land of Egypt, the same day came they into the wilderness of Sinai.
- Luke 9:31-who appeared in glory and spoke of <u>his departure</u>, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem.
- 2 Pet. 1:15-And I will make every effort so that after my **departure** you may be able at any time to recall these things.

## **Authorship**

- Exod. 17:14-Then the LORD said to <u>Moses, "Write</u> this as a memorial in a book and recite it in the ears of Joshua, that I will utterly blot out the memory of Amalek from under heaven.
- Josh. 8:31-as <u>Moses</u> the servant of Jehovah commanded the children of Israel, as it is written in the <u>book of the law of Moses</u>, an <u>altar of unhewn stones</u>, upon which no man had lifted up any iron: and they offered thereon burnt-offerings unto Jehovah, and sacrificed peace-offerings.
- Exod. 20:25-If you make me an altar of stone, you shall not build it of **hewn stones**, for if you wield your tool on it you profane it. And you shall not go up by steps to my altar, that your nakedness be not exposed on it.
- John 1:45-Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom <u>Moses in the law</u>, and the prophets, wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

#### **Date**

Exod. 7:7-Moses was <u>eighty years old</u> and Aaron eighty-three, when they spoke to Pharaoh.

Deut. 34:7-Although Moses was <u>one hundred and twenty</u> <u>years old when he died</u>, his eye was not dim, nor his vigor abated.

### **Audience**

Exod. 24:4-And Moses wrote down all the words of the LORD. He rose early in the morning and built an altar at the foot of the mountain, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of Israel.

## **Scope**

Exod. 19:1-In <u>the third month</u> after the children of Israel were gone forth out of the land of Egypt, <u>the same day</u> came they into the wilderness of Sinai.

Exod. 40:17-And it came to pass in the first month in the second year, on the first day of the month, that the tabernacle was reared up.

# **Christ in Exodus**

1 Cor. 5:7- Purge out the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, even as ye are unleavened. For **our passover also hath been sacrificed, even Christ**.

1 John 2:1- My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, **Jesus Christ the righteous.** 

Exod. 12:46-It shall be eaten in one house; you shall not take any of the flesh outside the house, and **you shall not break any of its bones**.

John 19:32-33-So the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first, and of the other who had been crucified with him. But when they came to Jesus and saw that he was already dead, **they did not break his legs**.

John 19:36-For these things took place that the Scripture might be fulfilled: "Not one of his bones will be broken."

1 Cor. 10:3-4-and all ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and **the Rock was Christ**.

John 6:31-35-Our fathers ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written, He gave them bread out of heaven to eat. Jesus therefore said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, It was not Moses that gave you the bread out of heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread out of heaven. For the bread of God is that which cometh down out of heaven, and giveth life unto the world. They said therefore unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread. <u>Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life</u>: he that cometh to me shall not hunger, and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

Heb. 4:14-16-<sup>14</sup> Since then we have a great high priest who has **passed through the heavens**, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. <sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been **tempted as we are, yet without sin**. <sup>16</sup> Let us

then with confidence <u>draw near to the throne of grace</u>, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
