<u>8</u>

Rom. 6:6-knowing this, that <u>our old self was crucified</u> <u>with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away</u> <u>with</u>, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin.

Rom. 6:14-For <u>sin shall not be master over you</u>, for you are not under law but under grace.

Gen. 13:15-for all the <u>land</u> which you see, I will give it to you and to your descendants forever.

Heb. 13:5- Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "<u>I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you</u>,"

Prov. 18:24- A man of too many friends comes to ruin, but <u>there</u> is a friend who sticks closer than a brother.

John 4:23-24-²³ But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in <u>spirit and truth</u>; for such people the <u>Father seeks to be His worshipers</u>. ²⁴ God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in <u>spirit and truth</u>."

<u>13</u>

Exod. 2:11-13-¹¹ Now it came about in those days, when Moses had grown up, that he went out to his brethren and looked on their hard labors; and he saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren. ¹² So he looked this way and that, and when he saw there was no one around, he struck down the Egyptian and hid him in the sand. ¹³ He went out the next day, and behold, two Hebrews were fighting with each other; and he said to the offender, "Why are you striking your companion?"

John 8:56-59-⁵⁶ Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad." ⁵⁷ So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?" ⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, **before Abraham was born, I** <u>**am**</u>."⁵⁹ Therefore they picked up <u>**stones**</u> to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

Lev. 24:16-Moreover, <u>the one who blasphemes the name of</u> <u>the Lord shall surely be put to death</u>; all the congregation shall certainly <u>stone</u> him. The alien as well as the native, when he blasphemes the Name, shall be put to death.

<u>18</u>

Exod. 2:14- But he said, "<u>Who made you a prince or a judge</u> over us? Are you intending to kill me as you killed the <u>Egyptian?</u>" Then Moses was afraid and said, "Surely the matter has become known."

<u>21-22</u>

Gen. 15:14- But I will also judge the nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out <u>with many possessions</u>.

Exod. 35:5- Take from among you a contribution to the Lord; whoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it as the Lord's contribution: **gold**, silver, and bronze.

Exod. 35:22- Then all whose hearts moved them, both men and women, came and brought brooches and earrings and signet rings and bracelets, all articles of gold; so did every man who presented an offering of **gold** to the Lord.

Prov. 13:22-A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, And <u>the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous</u>.
