Acts 8:35-Then **Philip opened his mouth**, and beginning from this Scripture he preached Jesus to him.

John 4:23-24-²³ But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in **spirit and truth**; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. ²⁴ God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in **spirit and truth**.

Matt. 7:21-23-²¹ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven *will enter*. ²² Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' ²³ And then I will declare to them, 'I never <u>knew</u> you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.'

John 16:1-3-These things I have spoken to you so that you may be kept from stumbling. ² They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God. ³ These things they will do because they have not **known** the Father or Me.

Exod. 3:19-But I know that the king of Egypt will not permit you to go, except under compulsion.

2 Tim. 3:12-Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

- Ps. 121:4-Behold, <u>He who keeps Israel</u> Will neither slumber nor sleep.
- 2 Cor. 6:14-16-¹⁴ Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? ¹⁵ Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? ¹⁶ Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I will dwell in them and walk among them; And I will be their God, and they shall be My people."
- 2 Cor. 6:17-Therefore, <u>come out from their midst and be</u> <u>separate</u>," says the Lord. "And do not touch what is unclean; And I will welcome you.
- Rev. 18:4-I heard another voice from heaven, saying, "Come out of her, my people, so that you will not participate in her sins and receive of her plagues."
- 1 John 1:9-If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Exod. 3:18-They will pay heed to what you say; and you with the elders of Israel will come to the king of Egypt and you will say to him, 'The Lord, the God of the Hebrews, has met with us. So now, please, let us go a three days' journey into the wilderness, that we may sacrifice to the Lord our God.'
- Exod. 4:24-26-²⁴ Now it came about at the lodging place on the way that the Lord met him and sought to put him to death. ²⁵ Then Zipporah took a flint and cut off her son's foreskin and threw it at Moses' feet, and she said, "You are indeed a

bridegroom of blood to me." ²⁶ So He let him alone. At that time she said, "You are a bridegroom of blood"—because of the circumcision.

Heb. 12:5-13-5 and you have forgotten the exhortation which is addressed to you as sons, "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, Nor faint when you are reproved by Him; ⁶ For those whom the Lord loves He disciplines, And He scourges every son whom He receives." ⁷ It is for discipline that you endure; God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom his father does not discipline? ⁸ But if you are without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. ⁹ Furthermore, we had earthly fathers to discipline us, and we respected them; shall we not much rather be subject to the Father of spirits, and live? ¹⁰ For they disciplined us for a short time as seemed best to them, but He disciplines us for our good, so that we may share His holiness. ¹¹ All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards the peaceful fruit yields of righteousness. ¹² Therefore, strengthen the hands that are weak and the knees that are feeble, ¹³ and make straight paths for your feet, so that the limbwhich is lame may not be put out of joint, but rather be healed.

Jas. 1:2-4- ² Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter <u>various trials</u>, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. ⁴ And let endurance have *its* perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Exod. 3:19-But I know that the king of Egypt will not permit you to go, except under compulsion.

1 Cor. 2:14-15- ¹⁴ But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised. ¹⁵ But he who is spiritual appraises all things, **yet he himself is appraised by no one**.
