Exod. 3:14-God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you."

John 8:58-59-⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, <u>I am</u>." Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

Lev. 24:16-Moreover, the one who blasphemes the name of the Lord-shall surely be put to death; all the congregation shall certainly **stone him**. The alien as well as the native, when he **blasphemes** the Name, shall be put to death.

2 Tim. 4:2-**preach the word**; be ready in season *and* out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.

Deut. 8:3-He humbled you and let you be hungry, and fed you with manna which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that He might make you understand that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by **everything** that proceeds out of the mouth of the Lord.

Jer. 1:6-7-⁶ Then I said, "Alas, Lord God! Behold, I do not know how to speak, Because I am a youth." ⁷ But the Lord said to me, "Do not say, 'I am a youth,' Because everywhere I send you, you shall go, And <u>all that I command you, you shall speak</u>.

Exod. 4:10-11- ¹⁰ Then Moses said to the Lord, "Please, Lord, I have <u>never been eloquent</u>, neither recently nor in time past, nor since You have spoken to Your servant; for I am <u>slow of speech</u> <u>and slow of tongue</u>." ¹¹ The Lord said to him, "<u>Who has made man's mouth?</u> Or who makes him mute or deaf, or seeing or blind? Is it not I, the Lord?

Jer. 1:6-7-⁶ Then I said, "Alas, Lord God! Behold, I do not know how to speak, Because I am a youth." ⁷ But the Lord said to me, "Do not say, 'I am a youth,' Because everywhere I send you, you shall go, And <u>all that I command you, you shall speak</u>.

2 Cor. 12:9-But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Judges 6:14-15-¹⁴ The Lord looked at him and said, "Go in this your strength and deliver Israel from the hand of Midian. Have I not sent you?" ¹⁵ He said to Him, "O Lord, how shall I deliver Israel? Behold, my family is the least in Manasseh, and I am the youngest in my father's house."

Rev. 3:7-8-7 "And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: He who is holy, who is true, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, and who shuts and no one opens, says this: 8 'I know your deeds. Behold, I have put before you an open **door** which no one can shut, because you have a **little power**, and have kept My word, and have not denied My name.

Isa. 6:8-10-8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!" ⁹ He said, "Go, and tell this people: 'Keep on listening, but do <u>not</u> perceive; Keep on looking, but do <u>not</u> understand.' ¹⁰ "Render the hearts of this people <u>insensitive</u>, Their ears <u>dull</u>, And their eyes <u>dim</u>, Otherwise they might see with their eyes, Hear with their ears, Understand with their hearts, And return and be healed."

Ezek. 3:17-19-¹⁷ "Son of man, I have appointed you a watchman to the house of Israel; whenever you hear a word from My mouth, warn them from Me.¹⁸ When I say to the wicked, 'You will surely die,' and you do not warn him or speak out to warn the wicked from his wicked way that he may live, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity, but his blood I will require at your hand. ¹⁹ Yet if you have warned the wicked and he does not turn from his wickedness or from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but **you have delivered yourself**.

Ezek. 33:7-9-7 "Now as for you, son of man, I have appointed you a watchman for the house of Israel; so you will hear a message from My mouth and give them warning from Me. 8 When I say to the wicked, 'O wicked man, you will surely die,' and you do not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity, but his blood I will require from your hand. 9 But if you on your part warn a wicked man to turn from his way and he does not turn from his way, he will die in his iniquity, but you have delivered your life.

1 Cor. 4:2-In this case, moreover, it is required of <u>stewards</u> that one be found <u>trustworthy</u>.

Matt. 25:21, 23- ²¹ His master said to him, 'Well done, good and <u>faithful</u> slave. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master...²³ His master said to him, 'Well done, good and <u>faithful</u> slave.
