<u>3</u>

Rom. 1:21-32-21 For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their foolish their speculations, and heart was darkened. <sup>22</sup> Professing be wise, to they fools, <sup>23</sup> and exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures. <sup>24</sup> Therefore **God gave them** over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them. <sup>25</sup> For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. persons the due penalty of their error. <sup>28</sup> And just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper, <sup>29</sup> being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of strife. deceit. murder. malice; they are gossips,<sup>30</sup> slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, <sup>31</sup> without untrustworthy, unloving, understanding, unmerciful; <sup>32</sup> and although they know the ordinance of God, that those who practice such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them.

<u>4</u>

Gen. 2:1-Thus the <u>heavens</u> and the earth were completed, and all their <u>hosts</u>.

1 Kgs. 22:19-Micaiah said, "Therefore, hear the word of the Lord. I saw the Lord sitting on His throne, and all the **host** of **heaven** standing by Him on His right and on His left.

Exod. 13:18-Hence God led the people around by the way of the wilderness to the Red Sea; and the sons of Israel went up in **martial array** from the land of Egypt.
