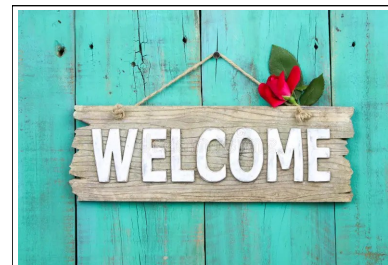

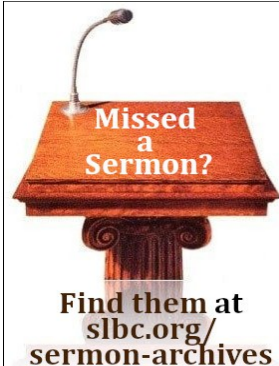
For those who are hearing impaired, we have Sound Mate hearing devices available to help you clearly hear and understand the service. Please ask a greeter where to obtain one.
